## PAYMENT METHODS: BANK DRAFT, PHONE, ONLINE (NEW!) AND AT THE SECOND ST Y

A deposit of \$25 per week is required at time of registration.

The \$25 per week deposit is not required when on bank draft!

However, there will be a cancellation fee of \$25 per week if the bank draft or registration is cancelled.

Campers must be paid in full the Friday before the attending week to attend camp.
