

WHAT SHOULD I BRING

Each camper should have enough clothes for one or more weeks. Below is a recommended packing list for one week of camp.

Second pair of shoes (sneakers, hiking boots, work boots).
Swimsuit (one piece for girls)
Belt
Hat
Pajamas
Warm Jacket

TOILET ARTICLES/BEDDING:

Toothbrush and toothpaste
Soap and soap dish
