## INCOME-BASED CAMP SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Bangor Region YMCA is a charitable, non-profit organization, whose mission is to be a community leader in supporting children, adults and families in their lifelong quest for physical, emotional and social wellness. The Bangor Region YMCA and its Board of Directors feels strongly that the YMCA is for everyone. No one will be turned away because of an inability to pay, subject to the availability of funds. The Bangor Region YMCA believes that a strong sense of ownership and pride is developed if the financial assistance recipient contributes to the cost of their YMCA involvement; therefore, applicants should be asked to pay an affordable portion of the camp fees.

### HOW TO APPLY

Each person requesting financial assistance, must complete a Scholarship Application and present a most recent tax return or statement of non-filing\*.

To process the application, membership staff will:

- Visually verify the Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) from the person's tax return
- Verify the member's signature on the Scholarship Application
- Complete the bottom of the Scholarship Application
- Have a second Bangor Region YMCA staff verify that both of you have visually verified the applicant's AGI and sign the bottom of the form
- Return the tax information back to the person

The Scholarship Application will be attached to the Camper's registration form.

At no time should the Bangor Region YMCA retain or copy the applicant's tax return for any Scholarship Application.

## FEE PAYMENT POLICY

The amount of \$\_\_\_\_\_ will be charged per week for summer camp services provided by the Bangor Region YMCA. Fees must be paid in full at time of registration or by scheduled bank draft; drafting from either saving/checking account or VISA/MasterCard credit/debit card. If the bank draft option is chosen, a \$25 non-refundable deposit per week per camper must be paid at time of registration or paid in full no later than Friday, June 8th, to reserve the camper's spot. The remaining balance for each week the camper is attending must be drafted no later than the Monday prior to the week attending.

Fees are based on enrollment, not attendance. Our desire is to enable every child who wants to come to camp the opportunity to do so. Unfortunately, we fill our allotted camper spots early and have to implement a waiting list. Due to this popularity of our camp, we must enforce a strict cancellation policy. If you have to cancel your scheduled time at camp, in addition to our non-refundable deposit, you will be charged a cancellation fee based upon the following schedule:

1. Prior to 7 weeks before your scheduled camp week, your non-refundable deposit only is applied.
2. Six weeks prior to your scheduled camp week, you will be charged 25% of your balance.

Once a swimmer turns 6 years old, he/she will progress from our Preschool Lessons into our Youth Lessons. This is a six-level program **designed so that each level builds upon the preceding one, continuously growing each swimmer's confidence in the water and knowledge of water safety.** Each swimmer will receive a progress report at the end of each session. All of our Polliwog and Guppy classes are taught with the use of instructional flotation devices.
