**Meet Location:** Canada Games Aquatic Centre – 50 Union St. – Saint John, New Brunswick,  
Canada

**Course:** Long Course Meters (50 meters)

**Facility:** Canada Games Aquatic Centre is an 8 lane 50 meter pool with non-turbulent lane lines, Colorado Timing System, Aqua Grip electronic pads, a nine-line readout scoreboard and spectator seating for 500. The facility also has two additional 2 lane 25 meter pools for warm-up/cool-down. The competition pool starting end has a depth of 10-14 feet and the turn end has depth of 3 feet, 6 inches (relay swimmers will start in the water in the shallow end for the 200 relays). The upper & lower warm-up/cool-down pools have a depth of 3 feet to 4.5 feet (there is no diving allowed). This pool has not been measured for certification under USA-S rule 104.2.2C(4).

**Meet Format:** This meet will be swum as trials/finals for 11-12, 13-14, and 15 & over (15&O) events 200 meters and shorter except for the 11-12 200 back, 200 breast and 200 fly which will be timed finals for 11-12 in prelims.

For prelim/final events, in prelims swimmers 11 & over will swim combined ages, but in finals they will compete, 11-12, 13-14 and 15 & O.

Finals of the prelim/final events will consist of two heats per age group (11-12, 13-14, 15-18), a championship heat and a consolation heat. All 10 & under events will be timed finals swum at night. The Meet Referee may combine finals heats to prevent empty lanes.

The 11 & over 400 freestyle, and the 13 & over 800 freestyle & 1500 freestyle are timed final events to be swum with prelims. The 11 & over 400 IM and the 10 & under 400 freestyle will be timed final events swum with finals. The 800 and 1500 freestyles will be swum fast to slow, alternating heats by gender, beginning with the fastest heat of each age group (older swimmers swimming first). After the top heats, following heats will be swum combined ages. Heats maybe combined to prevent empty lanes. The 11 & over 400 freestyle and 400 IM will be swum with the fastest heat of 11-12's followed by 13-14's and then 15 & overs. The rest of the heats will be swum fast to slow combined ages.

All events will follow the scratch procedure. There is no positive check-in for any events including the 800 and 1500 freestyles. The Meet Director/Meet Referee reserves the right to limit the 800 & 1500 freestyles to the fastest 16 swimmers in each group to ensure the meet timeline. Teams will be notified by July 18, 2019 of any swimmers that are scratched from these events. Teams/swimmers will have 36 hours after notification to add an event(s) for any swimmer affected.

Any relays that are not scratched by the scratch deadline will be charged \$100 for missing a relay with the exception of a medical excuse or declared false start.

**Meet Jury:** The Meet Jury will be made up of one official, one coach, and one athlete to be selected by the Meet Referee who will present issues and moderate the jury, but not vote. The three members shall be from separate teams. The Meet Jury will decide all issues of eligibility and anything not addressed in the Meet Announcement. The Meet Referee shall have authority as described in the current USA Swimming Rulebook.

**Weather Protocol:** If weather or facility conditions make it impossible to follow the original timeline of events, the Meet Director and Meet Referee have a right to make changes to the meet sessions. The Meet Director will notify the teams of the changes with as much notice as possible. **Cancellation of the meet, or a session**, is the decision of the Meet Director, Meet Referee and the Meet Jury.

**Swimmers with Disabilities:** Swimmers with disabilities are welcome to enter this meet. **At the time the entry is submitted**, the coach or team entry contact person should contact the Meet Director and Meet Referee when entries are submitted as to the need for any special accommodations or seeding arrangements.

**Eligibility:** This meet is open to any swimmer who is properly registered with United States Swimming or Swimming Canada for 2019. Please note, that all swimmers must be

registered by the entry deadline (July 16, 2019) to be eligible to swim in the International Invitational. Swimmers not registered by the entry deadline will have 36 hours to register after notification from the Meet Director or the Maine Swimming Office to submit registration and payment to the Maine Swimming office. Swimmers transferring into MESI from another LSC or transferring to another MESI Club must have their transfer requests processed by the Maine Swimming Office prior to the entry deadline in order to be eligible to compete as Maine in the MESIII.

**Any USA-S swimmer who is age 18 or older must have completed the [Athlete Protection Training \(APT\)](#) before entry. Swimmers who have not complied with this MAAPP policy will be scratched.**

**Swimwear:** Swimmers 10 years old and younger are not permitted to wear "Tech" suits at this meet. A complete list of the policy may be found at [www.maineswimming.org](http://www.maineswimming.org) under policies

**USA-S Registration:** Club athletes may obtain USA-S Registration from their Club Registrar. Unattached athletes may obtain forms and instructions from the Maine Swimming Web Site; [www.maineswimming.org](http://www.maineswimming.org). Deck Registrations will not be allowed. Direct registration questions to the Maine Swimming, Inc. Membership/Registration Chair, Mary Ellen Tynan, 978-996-9655 or [meswimoffice@gmail.com](mailto:meswimoffice@gmail.com). It's each team's responsibility to make sure the entry and registration information for each of their swimmers is accurate. Registration reconciliation will be done for this meet.

**Entry Deadline:** Entries will be accepted for Maine Swimming and New Brunswick teams until Tuesday, July 16, 2019 (11:59 pm EDT). Entries for teams outside of Maine and New Brunswick will be accepted as of the date of publication of this meet announcement. Entries from teams outside of Maine and New Brunswick are due no later than June 9, 2019. Entries after this date will be accepted if space allows. A maximum of 150 swimmers from outside of Maine & New Brunswick, will be accepted. These teams/swimmers will be notified by June 19, 2019 if they have been accepted into the meet. We will allow updated times until the meet entry deadline for all teams.

**Qualifying Period:** All times must be achieved between April 1, 2018 and July 15, 2019.

**Entry Submission:** Electronic entries in CL2 or SD3/SDIF or HY3 format should be emailed as an attachment to: Louis Arruda ([msientries@gmail.com](mailto:msientries@gmail.com)) and Mary Ellen Tynan ([meswimoffice@gmail.com](mailto:meswimoffice@gmail.com)). Non-electronic entries may be submitted via email entry for an additional \$1.00 per individual event and \$2.00 per relay. All non-electronic entries must be typed or printed legibly, and must use full names and registration numbers from USA Swimming registration. No refunds will be given for entries that are accepted or for entries that are rejected due to improper entry.

Entries for timed final events will be converted to long course meters and entries for prelim events will be seeded in the following order long course meters (LCM), short course meters (SCM), short course yards (SCY). **SCY and SCM times must not be converted to LCM prior to being submitted.** Coaches' times are not allowed. If a swimmer has not competed in an event in any course during the qualifying period please use NT. All times in the 800 and 1500 freestyles must be in SWIMS or provable from a Swimming Canada Meet. If a swimmer has a time in SWIMS for the 800 freestyle they may swim the 1500 freestyle and vice versa.

Deck entries will not be accepted.

Make checks payable to MAINE SWIMMING INC. Teams should send one check for all of their entries. **Payments must be received by July 22, 2019** unless other arrangements are made with the Maine Swimming Office. Payment may also be made online using the Pay Now button and the custom amount link. A contact sheet is attached. This must be filled out and returned with your e-mailed entries. **Please note that your entries will not be considered complete until this form is returned.**

A Hy-tek team entry list will be sent to each team to check the accuracy of their entries. Please review this and respond within 24 hours even if there are no corrections.

**Maine Teams that have not submitted their entries by the entry deadline will be contacted by noon the following day by the meet entry chairperson and will have until noon on the following day to submit their entries and will be subjected to a fine of \$250 plus \$10 per individual .Any entries submitted thereafter will be entered only at the discretion of the Meet Committee.**

Coaches must submit a contact number or contact information where they can receive a message in between prelims and finals in case a swimmer scratches in to finals and needs to be notified. This information should be submitted on the contact sheet with team entries.

**Proof of Time:**

Proof of all entry times by athlete must be submitted with the entry. Proof of entry time must be a pdf copy of the Meet Entry Report from Team Manager or Team Unify *sorted by name*; under other options for the report include proof of time. Coach times will be not be accepted. The 800 freestyle & 1500 freestyle times must be in the SWIMS database or from a provable Canada meet. Proof of entry time must be a copy of the Meet Entry Report from Team Manager or Team Unify *sorted by name*; under other options for the report include proof of time. Coach times will be not be accepted. Time reconciliation will be done for this meet.

**Entry Limits:**

Swimmers may enter as many events as they would like however may only compete in a maximum of three **(3)** individual events per day and seven **(7)** individual events for the meet (not including relays). 10&U swimmers are limited to 3 relay events (1 relay/day) and 11&O swimmers may swim in 4 relay events (1 on each Thursday and Friday and 2 on Saturday).

Clarification of relays

1. 10 & under swimmer may swim in 12&U & 14&U relays, but NOT in 11 & over relays.
2. The Mixed 200 Medley Relays MUST consist of 2 boys and 2 girls in any order.

**Scratch procedure:** On Tuesday, July 23<sup>rd</sup>, coaches will receive a scratch sheet for the Thursday AM session via email. Scratches must be emailed and/or submitted to the Admin Referee and Entry Chairperson by Thursday at 7AM for all Thursday prelim events. For Friday and Saturday, scratch sheets will be provided by 5PM. If a swimmer does not scratch and they have more than 3 events that day, they will be scratched from their last events of that day. If by Saturday they have more than 7 events, the last events for the meet

will be scratched. To scratch a swimmer, draw a single line through the relay and/or swimmer. To scratch a single event for a swimmer, draw a single line through that event only.

Friday and Saturday prelim scratches will be due to the Admin Referee by 7PM the night before. This includes scratches for the Mixed 200 Medley Relays.

Scratches for 10 & unders and relays will be due to the Admin Referee by 11:00am on the days of the events.

**Any swimmer who misses a timed final or prelim event will not be penalized; however, any swimmer who missed the finals of a prelim/final event will be barred from the remainder of the meet. If an athlete misses a final event, they will be permitted to compete for the rest of the meet as time trial-only swimmers. This includes any relays where they may be entered. No additional time trial fees will apply to these swimmers. Any relays that are not scratched by the scratch deadline will be charged \$100 for missing a relay with the exception of a medical excuse or declared false start.**

**Entry Fees:**

All entry fees are to be paid in US Dollars (US\$).

Participation Fee: There will be a \$15.00 participation fee for all swimmers entered in the meet including relay only swimmers.

**Time Trials:**

Time trials will be scheduled at the discretion of the Meet Director and the Meet Referee based on available time. Coaches wanting a swimmer to swim a time trial should make that request to the Meet Director at any time during the meet. The entry fee for a time trial is \$15.00US (\$30.00US for a Relay). An individual time trial counts toward the maximum allowed three (3) individual events per day, but not towards the limit of seven (7) events for the meet. A relay time trial does not count towards the allowed relays/day for each swimmer.

**Officials:**

All certified officials are welcome and encouraged to work at the meet. Officials should contact the Meet Referee to sign-up in advance of the meet. Your help in making this meet a success will be greatly appreciated.

**Admission:**

No charge for admission.

**Programs:**

The cost of the meet program will be \$15US or \$20C. Prelim and final heat will be free to all that have purchased and shown the meet program. It will be \$5.00US or \$5C for all others to purchase a one session heat sheet.

**Vendor:**

Northwest Design will be selling t-shirts and other apparel throughout the meet.

**Psych Sheet:**

The psych sheet will be available by Noon (12:00PM EDT) on Monday, July 22, 2019 on the MESI Website.

**Meet Policies:**

Only registered coaches, officials, and swimmers or a member of the meet staff will be access to the pool deck including the bleachers. All non-athletes on the pool deck must display their current USA Swimming registration card or display their current Deck Pass when requested. Individuals unable to provide current registration will be removed from the pool deck

Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Current USA Swimming rules will govern all competition. Decisions by the Meet Referee will be final unless a written protest is lodged within 30 minutes of the heat swum. A swimmer may compete under protest during appeal of a decision of the MESI Board of Directors or MESI House of Delegates only upon presentation of a written protest and its required fee of \$100US or \$150CAN to the General Chair.

All swimmers, coaches and officials will follow the USA Swimming code of conduct under article 304 of the USA Swimming rules and regulations. Any violation of such policy will be reported to the Meet Referee and the Maine Swimming office for further review and/or action.

Kinesio-tape or any other type of body tape is strictly prohibited.

**Start Procedure:**

This meet will be conducted using the no recall false start rule, the whistle command starting procedure and 'fly-over' starts. All swimmers (except for Backstroke starts) cannot exit the water until all swimmers have finished their races/relay legs and MUST exit the pool from the sides of the pool (Lanes 1 & 8), not the end of the pool.

**Safety:**

1. Diving will be prohibited during warm-ups except in specifically announced one-way sprint lanes. There will be no diving in the warm-up and warm-down areas at any time
2. No shaving is permitted at the competition site.
3. No glass containers are permitted within the facility.
4. Swimmers must be under the supervision of a coach. If a swimmer arrives at the meet without a coach, the swimmer should notify the referee before he/she warms up. The referee will assign the swimmer to a registered coach for warm-ups.
5. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms, locker rooms, behind the blocks, or in any marked NO CAMERA ZONE.
6. Deck changes are prohibited
7. Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, Spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.

**Photography:**

As per Maine Swimming policy, with the exception of photographers hired by MESI only coaches may video or take photographs from the pool deck. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted behind the starting blocks, including in any spectator area behind the starting blocks, nor in any other marked NO CAMERA ZONE, including on deck. All NO CAMERA ZONES will be clearly designated. Email the Meet Director with questions and

**Warm-ups:**

**USA Swimming and Maine Swimming safety procedures will be enforced throughout the meet. Warm-ups are subject to the following procedures:**

All swimmers shall enter feet first using the sit and slide method at the starting end of the pool. The warm-up sessions may be divided into periods of equal length depending on the number of swimmers entered in each session. Warm-up schedules will be posted on the web site prior to the meet and will be made available to coaches at the meet. Sprint lanes will be announced during the warm up period. No diving or backstroke starts will be permitted except in sprint lanes, when designated, except under a coach's supervision in team assigned lanes. **Swimmers without a coach must report to the Meet Director prior to the warm-up to obtain a lane assignment.**

**Timers, Marshals, & Clean-up:**

Each team will be responsible for coordinating and providing timers for any specified lanes, marshals for the assigned session (**marshals do not need to be USA-S registered**), clean-up following the assigned session and other duties as assigned by the Meet Director. The assignments will be determined at the completion of meet entries and teams will be notified by e-mail and/or the MESI Website by Friday, July 20, 2018. Timers, marshals and other meet staff who are not USA-S registered must sign a USA- S waiver form. Marshals (cannot be a registered coach for that session) will be placed at the four corners of the pool (or other spots assigned by Meet Director/Referee) and may not be coaching swimmers while ensuring the safety of all the participants as a marshal. Marshals must attend a quick meeting 5 minutes before their appointed session. Warmup for each session will not begin until all the Marshals are present. Please note that the MESI Policy and Procedures requires each team with a minimum of 5 swimmers entered in a session to have at least one non-athlete available for jobs as assigned. If a worker fails to show up for a job in timely fashion the team will be subject to a fine of \$25.00 per job assignment. If your team is assigned to be a timer you are responsible to ensure it's covered until the end of the session even if your team has no swimmers entered in those events. 800 & 1500 free swimmers must provide their own timers.

**Safe Sport:**

The conduct of all participants and spectators at a meet is governed by USA Swimming Rules 304/305. Any and all infractions must be reported to an official, the Referee or the Meet Director to be resolved.
